4. What is citizenship? How has the concept evolved over the years? Do you agree that we are today moving towards 'post-national' citizenship?
5. What is outward-oriented development strategy? Why has it been difficult for many developing countries to switch from inward-oriented to outward-oriented development strategy?
6. Write an essay on growth performance of the Indian economy under different economic policy regimes since independence.

8. Examine the impact of the Treaty of Versailles on the post-World War I developments and the rise of fascism in Europe.
9. What is sovereign debt crisis? Explain the reasons for the current debt crisis in some of the Eurozone economies.
10. Multiculturalism has failed in Europe. Discuss.
11. What is regional integration? Can European integration serve as a model for South Asia?
12. What is systemic change? Critically evaluate the economic and political changes in the Central and Eastern Europe since 1989.
